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**SUBJECT:** Entrust Service Delivery Agreement

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#### **BACKGROUND:**

In February Cabinet agreed to the termination of services under the service delivery agreement because a sustainable financial arrangement could not be agreed between the Council and Capita for the arrangements to continue as proposed by Capita.

Subsequently negotiations have taken place that confirm some services to cease and return to Council direct delivery but also some services to remain under a varied service delivery agreement.

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#### **REASONS WHY THE MAKING OF THE DECISION IS URGENT AND CANNOT REASONABLY AWAIT THE NEXT SCHEDULED MEETING OF THE CABINET:**

The decision can be made at the next Cabinet meeting on 15<sup>th</sup> June but the decision would need to be implemented by the 30<sup>th</sup> June in accordance with the current contractual terms. This does not allow sufficient time for scrutiny and further consideration by Cabinet.
