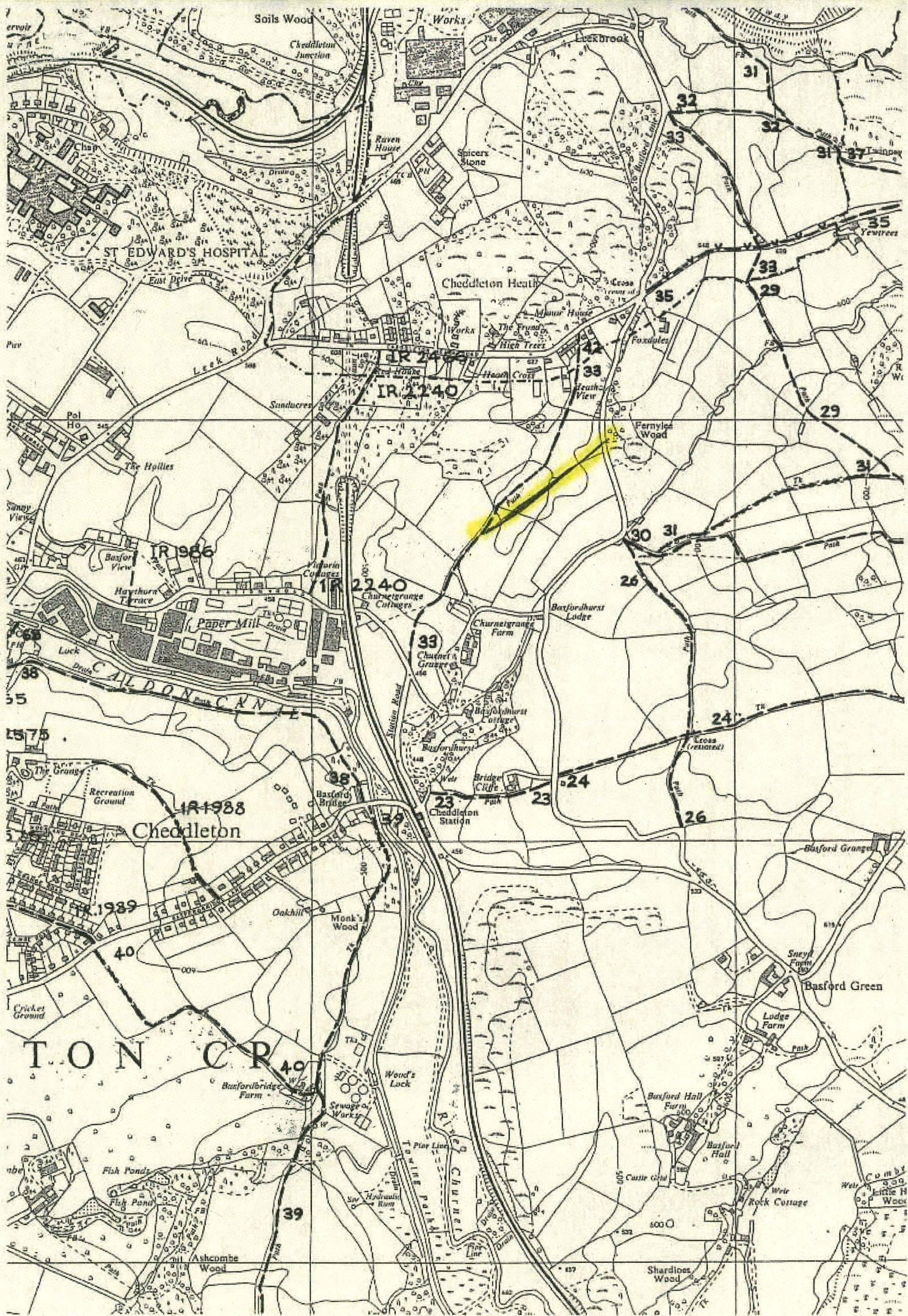

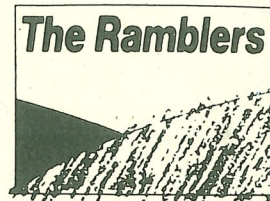

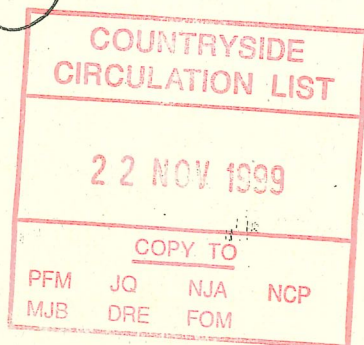

ALLEGED FOOTPATH AT CHEDDLETON.

I have enclosed 2 discs containing copies of the order plan and schedule. Please feel free to copy them. Please can you return them to me.

The southern part of the footpath shown on the order plan is an existing public footpath.

I am only claiming the northern part of the path leading from the existing public path to Basford Lane. (Red on enclosed map).

I cannot find any maps showing the claimed path, but there is a certificate of completion which I have enclosed.

The order seems to stop up part of the existing public footpath that leads to Cheddleton Heath Rd. Public rights on foot must have been re-established for this footpath because it has become a definitive public

footpath. A hundred years had passed from the date of the order to the date that the definitive map was produced. This was ample time for rights to be re-established through usage.
